Celebrating a Summer of God's Goodness



While we did not meet our goal of 700 campers (559 campers participated, roughly the same number as last year), we saw God work in wonderful ways. God demonstrated his faithfulness to us by providing us with everything we needed and keeping our staff and campers safe from serious injury or illness. God provided ample rain to supply our wells with water both in the spring ahead of camp as well as in the summer. He provided us with a great staff and volunteers with servant hearts and a love for others.

We are also grateful for the spiritual fruit that we were able to witness this summer. A large number of campers expressed to their counselors that they made some sort of spiritual decision during their time at Judson—26 made salvation decisions, 10 recommitted their lives to Christ, 5 made a commitment to daily devotions, 45 made commitments to pray more regularly, 16 committed themselves to attend church regularly, and 71 committed themselves to regular Bible reading.

All totaled, approximately 30% of our campers made some sort of spiritual decision! This does not include decisions made that were not shared with staff, or all the seeds that were planted that God will continue to cultivate through local churches and other individuals in the weeks and years ahead.

Please continue to pray for our campers as they go about their lives away from Judson, that God will continue to work in their lives and draw them closer to Jesus.

Coming to Judson This Fall and Winter

Winter Blast Youth Retreats

Students in grades 7 to 12, their friends and youth groups, and their youth leaders are invited to join us for a weekend of worship, friends, and fun.

Each weekend will include several sessions of worship and teaching (worship leaders and presenters to be determined) as well as a wide variety of indoor and outdoor activities. The retreat will be offered the weekend of January 20-22 and if there is sufficient demand from students and youth groups, we will add a second weekend in January or early February. The cost for the weekend is \$80.

4:12 Student Leadership Academy

Brochures and information will be available and sent out to students and churches in the early fall.

One of the goals of Camp Judson is to help local church congregations to develop the next generation of Christian leaders within their local church. To accomplish this goal, we are launching the 4:12 Student Leadership Academy to provide teenagers with an opportunity to participate in Christian leadership training and then have the opportunity to apply what they are learning and discovering by serving in their local church with the assistance of a mentor in their local congregation.

The program takes its name and inspiration from 1 Timothy 4:12, "Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity."

The program will offer three to four instructional sessions each year at Judson or some other ministry site, with the idea that students will take what they have learned back to their

local church and have the opportunity to put it into practice. Instructional sessions will focus on subjects such as spiritual gift discovery, spiritual growth, evangelism, discipleship, and servanthood to name a few.

The cost of the program will be between \$25 and \$50 per session for each student, and we will be asking churches and other individuals to assist by investing in the future of the church by sponsoring students who wish to participate.

Interested students will be required to complete an application, submit a recommendation from their pastor, youth leader, or Sunday School teacher, along with the name of someone from their congregation who has agreed to serve as their mentor in the local church.

Detailed information about this new program and applications for students to sign up will be mailed out to students, youth leaders, pastors, and churches in early September and will appear in the October issue of the Judson Journal.

Erie Gives!

On August 2, the Erie Community Foundation celebrated it's 75th anniversary with Erie Gives, an online giving event where the foundation offered matching funds for all funds given to organizations on the Erie Gives website in a twelve hour period. In just twelve hours, the foundation raised over \$770,000 for non-profits around the Erie area, including over \$4500 for Camp Judson. Including the 14% match from the foundation, Camp Judson received just over \$5100 through this event! Thanks to everyone who spread the word about Erie Gives in such a short amount of time from when we announced our participation the week before.



Scholarship Program Update

Through the Camper Assistance Program this summer we were able to help 166 campers get to camp at a cost of \$42,145. However, as you may have heard, to this point we have only received just over \$21,000. Campers who received CAP funds come from both urban and rural communities, a variety of ethnic and racial backgrounds, and request CAP funds for a variety of reasons ranging from a chronic unemployment or underemployment, unexpected expenses for medical bills or car or home repairs.
