

**Recreational Facilities:**

Campsites are by the day or week. Reservations can be made for a campsite on a first serve basis via telephone or mail. Reservations can be made on or after April 1<sup>st</sup>. To reserve a campsite please indicate your date of arrival and your date of departure and if you will need a site with hook-ups (water & electric or just electric) or no hook-ups. One day's payment for a campsite must be made with a check or credit card (Visa, Discover, or MasterCard) to reserve your site. This one day's fee (deposit) is not refundable. Your reservation will be confirmed. Holiday weekends (Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, and Labor Day) campsites are rented for three nights only. Seasonal campsites have electric and water hook-ups. Please check in the camp office about the availability of seasonal sites since there is a waiting list.

As time allows, we offer our camp ground guests a chance to experience the climbing wall, zip line and to ride the horses. Please check with the office for possible availability.

## ► Campsite Rules and Regulations

**Check out:** Check out time is 12:00 Noon

**Fires:** Because of invasive insects, you cannot transport your own firewood to the campgrounds! All fires must be confined to the fire ring provided. Firewood is \$2.00 a bundle, payable at the office during office hours or the money tube on firewood rack. Please keep all firewood in fire ring or under trailer so we are able to mow grass.

**Pets:** Your pets are welcome; however, for their safety as well as the safety of others, they must be kept on a leash at all times. There are no exceptions to this rule. Pets are prohibited in the camp's buildings. **You are responsible for cleaning up after your pet. Owners of pets which are aggressive or disruptive will be asked to remove the pet(s) from the campground.**

**Recreational Vehicles:** 4-wheelers cannot be used for any other reason than to launch your boat or jet ski into the lake. They should only be operated by someone who is at least 21 years old. They are not to be ridden elsewhere on camp or neighboring properties.

**Sanitation:** Do not drain wastewater or sewage onto the ground. You must have a sewage tank (portable) connected to your camper. Roll your sewage tank to the dumping station to empty it. Please use the trashcans for all refuse. **No big items** such as lawn furniture, awnings, toys, etc. Do not burn your garbage.

**Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs:** Alcoholic beverages and drugs will not be tolerated on the campgrounds. This will be enforced by asking you to leave.

**Fireworks & Firearms:** No fireworks or firearms will be permitted at any time.

**Vegetation:** Please do not pick, remove, or damage any vegetation here at camp or neighboring properties. Do not chop down your own firewood or sticks for roasting hot dogs.

**Guests:** There is no additional charge for short term guests visiting you at your camper. Over night guests who wish to park their camper or pitch their tent on your site are required to pay the daily rate. However all your guests are responsible for following the rules. There is a fee of \$2.00 for your guests to use the pool. **Note: Seasonal campers – If your guests stay at your camper more than 2 weeks you will be assessed the daily rate for each additional day they stay.**

**Beachwear:** Scantily clad bathers and thong bathing suits are unacceptable.

**Quiet Hours:** Most campers are here to enjoy some peace and quiet. Please respect your neighbor's privacy and feelings by keeping radios at a low volume. From 11pm to 7 am quiet hours are in effect. Any sound coming from your site should not be loud enough to disturb your neighbors. Quiet hours will be enforced.

**Other Campers:** During the summer, several different camping groups use the facilities of

Camp Judson. Please try to avoid distracting these groups which may be meeting in various areas of the camp.

**Emergencies:** If an emergency of any sort arises, please call 911 if able or contact the camp office. If the office is not open, please go to the Manager's home located by the pond or maintenance man's trailer in side yard. The nearest hospital is University Hospital Systems-BMH, located 12 miles west of camp along Route 20 in Conneaut, Ohio.
