Get a Discount on Your Registration!

Here's how you can receive a discount on your registration for Summer Camp:

- 1.) First Time campers receive \$20 off their registration. All they have to do is sign up!
- 2.) Campers who invite a first-time camper receive \$20 off their registration (Discounts will be given to the camper listed as the "person who invited you" on a First-time camper's registration form. First-time camper does not have to attend your camp session.)

Please note: Each camper is eligible to receive a maximum of \$20 off of their camp registration.

Judson Day Offering Funds New Dock and PFDs

Thanks to the generosity of many churches and individuals to this year's Judson Day Offering enabled us to replace the old pond dock with a new and larger pond dock. The new dock is located just to the west of where the old dock stood and has a ladder for campers and staff to get in and out of the pond as well as handrails on one side which is wide enough for a wheelchair. The fish (and snapping turtles) have already adjusted to the new location of bread thrown in the pond to feed them!

The offering also allowed us to replace the old life jackets with new ones that are useable not only in the pond for canoeing, but also in the lake for sailing and jet skiing.

JDO money is still being received, so we do not have a final count on how much the offering has raised, but all funds received over the total needed to cover the costs and the life jackets (about \$4000) will be used to in the horsemanship program and the increasing costs of feed for the horses.

Camping is for Families Too

If you want the excitement of camp for your whole family together, consider coming for Family Camp (July 2-5)! Family campers have the option of staying in the campground or in one of the cabins and participate in age appropriate activities for the whole family led by Judson staff, as well as Bible studies and vespers geared for families under the leadership of Roscoe Bennett and Kevin Saxton. If you can't come to Family Camp, but would still like to get away with your family for a night or two, consider staying in the Lakeside Campgrounds at Camp Judson with its spectacular lake views. Campsites with hookups are just \$30/night and without for just \$25/night anytime between May 15 and October 15. Reservations are recommended to ensure availability upon arrival.
